



## Montana Broadcasters Association Hall of Fame

The Montana Broadcasters Association *Hall of Fame* recognizes individuals who have made a significant contribution to broadcasting and their community in the state of Montana. The Hall of Fame is open to individuals in all aspects of the broadcast industry: ownership, management, news, engineering, production, sales, promotion, on-air talent, creative services or associated professional fields. The selection committee will judge nominations on the following criteria:

1. Candidates for the MBA Hall of Fame shall have worked in Montana broadcasting or an associated professional field to the benefit of the Montana broadcast industry.
2. Candidates for the Montana Broadcaster's Hall of Fame are judged to have made a *significant and lasting* contribution to the Montana broadcasting industry. In doing so, they are judged by the nominating committee to have distinguished themselves among their Montana peers.
3. Hall of Fame candidates will be considered on the full extent of their career. Time in the industry will be considered but is not necessarily a requirement. Nominees will be held in file for consideration for five years. If there is no additional information submitted within the five year time period, the nomination becomes inactive.
4. Hall of Fame status will be awarded without regard to age.
5. All disciplines qualify for consideration. (Ownership, Management, Sales, Journalism, Engineering, Creative Services.)
6. In the event that no one person meets the nominating committee's requirements for induction into the Montana Broadcaster Hall of Fame, the committee shall recommend that no induction be made. If the nominating committee deems that more than one person merits immediate consideration, they may recommend multiple nominations.

For the 2012 class, nominations must be **received** by March 30, 2012. Please **do not** submit original material. No material will be returned and all nomination files become the property of the Montana Broadcasters Association. Please keep copies of all material submitted.
